Patient Organizations Grants Eligibility and Exclusionary Criteria

Patient Organization Grants: This funding is designed to support not for profit organizations in their mission to support the needs of patients.

All Grant Requests are reviewed in accordance with the [Innovative Medicines Canada Code of Ethical Practices \(IMC\)](#).

Eligibility Criteria

Requests may be accepted for review from registered Canadian not for profit organizations that serve the interests of patients.

Exclusionary Criteria

Requests will not be accepted from:

- Academic Institutions
- Hospitals
- Medical Societies
- Professional Associations
- Continuing Professional Development (CPD) Providers
- Individuals
- Private Clinics
- For Profit Organizations
- Medical Education Agencies/Vendors

Ineligible Grant Requests may include but are not limited to:

- Grant Requests for funding outside of Canada
- Invitation to Janssen Inc., to control, influence or participate in the design or conduct of the activity or to acquire a tangible benefit.
- Research/Clinical activities (including patient involvement and Investigator Initiated Studies)
- Grant Requests with the intent that Janssen Inc.'s funding would cover the entire costs involved to run the program/project.
- Medical education grants for Health Care Providers
- Grants to individuals
- Personal travel
- Entertainment
- Operating expenses to support existing costs associated with equipment, textbooks or subscriptions to publications, online meeting platforms, website development, phone lines, etc.

- Overhead costs (i.e., salaries, rent, insurance, utilities, etc.)
- Professional career development
- Requests for programs that have already started or are in progress.
- Recognition awards
- Prizes
- Charitable Contributions
- Grants Requests to support only food and beverage.
- Activities held in lavish venues/resort locations that do not meet the criteria as stated in IMC.
- Travel costs for any non-faculty participants
